

India to Malaysia

Requirements/Conditions:

Please note that Malaysians and Non-Malaysians (who allowed for entry) are subject to the following conditions:

1. Download **“MySejahtera”** App and complete all the necessary information.
2. Undergo a 14 days quarantine at Quarantine Station by following the quarantine procedures prescribed by the National Disaster Management Agency (NADMA) & Ministry of Health (MoH).
3. Undergo the COVID-19 test at the entrance upon arrival.
4. Valid visa is required for countries that require a visa to enter Malaysia.
5. Fill up the Letter of Undertaking (LoU) (could be downloaded from www.nadma.gov.my) and the duly completed form to be submitted to the the High Commission of Malaysia by email mwdelhi@kln.gov.my at least 3 days before departure. LoU could be submitted to the Consulate General of Malaysia Mumbai (mwmumbai.kln@1govuc.gov.my) and the Consulate General of Malaysia Chennai (mwchennai@kln.gov.my).
6. An expatriate has obtained a valid Entry Approval Letter/ Exit and Entry Approval Letter. Entry Approval Letter / Exit and Entry Approval Letter issued before 21st September 2020 is usable provided it is still valid.
7. Obtained **Letter Permission To Perform Journey to Malaysia** from High Commission of Malaysia / Consulate General of Malaysia Mumbai / Consulate General of Malaysia Chennai.

Effective 21st September 2020, the following category passengers are allowed entry into Malaysia:

1. Malaysians
2. Diplomats who are under Exemption Order and their dependent
3. Seafarers entering Malaysia for “sign-on” or “joint ship”
4. Pilot and Flight Attendance of commercial or private jet who are coming as a crew or passenger with General Declaration for the next flight
5. Patient and a companion with Entry Approval Letter from Malaysia Healthcare Travel Council (MHTC)

Additionally, the following expatriate may apply an Entry Approval Letter from the Immigration Department of Malaysia for entry into Malaysia:

1. New Diplomat and staff at Foreign Missions in Malaysia (including UN Laissez Passer (UNLP) holders
2. Valid Resident Pass-Talent (RP-T) holder and dependent including maid (to the RP-T)
3. Valid Employment Pass (EP) holder category I, II & III) and dependent including maid (to the EP)
4. Valid Professional Visit Pass (PVP) holder
5. Valid Long-Term Social Visit Pass (LTSVP) dependent to EP/RP-T
6. Valid Single-Entry Visa (SEV) / Approved Pass of EP / RP-T / PVP / LTSVP
7. Valid Single-Entry Visa (SEV) / Approved Pass of dependent including maid to RP-T / EP.

To update, the following non-Malaysian citizens are allowed entry into Malaysia during the MCO period:

1. Entry **without** Entry Approval Letter from Immigration Department of Malaysia

1. Malaysians
2. Permanent Residents (MyPR holders)
3. Diplomatic Passport holders from foreign missions in Malaysia
4. spouse / children to Malaysians who are holding valid Long Term Social Visit Pass

2. Entry **without** Entry Approval Letter from Immigration Department of Malaysia

1. valid Employment Pass Category I (EP I) holder / dependant and maid (to the EP I)
2. valid Resident Pass-Talent (RP-T) holder / dependant and maid (to the RP-T)
3. valid Single Entry Visa (SEV) of EP I / RP-T / dependant / maid

3. Entry **with** Entry Approval Letter from Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia (MOFA)

1. officials (including family members) from foreign missions in Malaysia

4. Entry **with** Entry Approval Letter from Immigration Department of Malaysia

1. valid Employment Pass Category II and III (EP) holders / dependant and maid (to the EP)
2. valid Resident Pass (RP) holder / dependent (to the RP)
3. valid Student Pass holder
4. valid Long Term Social Visit Pass (LTSVP) children above 18 years old / parents / parent in-Law
5. valid Professional Visit Pass (PVP) holder
6. valid Single Entry Visa (SEV) of EP / student / LTSVP / PVP
7. valid (Temporary Employment) Visit Pass holder

5. Entry **with** Entry Approval Letter from Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture Malaysia (MOTAC)

1. valid Visit Pass (Social) Malaysia My Second Home (MM2H) holder

6. Entry **with** Entry Approval Letter from Malaysia Healthcare Travel Council (MHTC)

Transiting in Malaysia

Kindly be informed that **transiting in Malaysia** is allowed under the following conditions:

1. Transit time is WITHIN 48 hours
2. Hand Baggage weighing 7 kgs and fits into the overhead bins. Check-in baggage will not be allowed.
3. Confirmed onward ticket and permission for entry into destination is mandatory.
4. Transit without leaving the Transit Hall.
5. Passengers must book and stay at Sama-Sama Express Hotel, KLIA located at Satellite Building at KLIA near C5 gate for Transit above 24 hours.

***Transit passengers are required to check the Government Website of the destination country for the latest updates on transit procedure.**

Due to certain Government restrictions, Transit Passengers to Hong Kong will not be accepted to travel in India to Kuala Lumpur flights till 03rd October 2020.

In view of the above, please note that the passengers need to ensure that their check in baggage will be automatically transferred to the next connecting flight as they are not allowed to leave the transit hall to collect their check in baggage.
