

Japan Airlines Announces Frequency Reduction on Tokyo – Delhi Flight

By Virtue of Air Travel Bubble which is created between India and Japan, designated carriers of both the countries are now permitted to operate services between India and Japan.

Japan Airlines wish to update Our trade partner pertaining to change in frequency related to Haneda – Delhi Flight, this shall come into effect starting from 13th May 2021.

- ❖ Both Indian and Japanese airlines while operating inbound flights into India can carry the following passengers:
 1. Stranded Indian nationals,
 2. All Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholders holding passports of Japan, and
 3. Foreigners(includingdiplomats) holding valid visaissued by an Indian Mission inanycategory covered under Ministry Of Home Affairs (MHA) guidelines, as amended from time to time.
 4. There is a mandatory requirementof travel related information/ self-declaration/ related documentation by passenger itself, Passenger must visit the below link for self-declaration.

 7. Mandatory Negative RT PCR Report with test conducted within 72 hours prior to the departure of Flight from TYO.
