

India to Muscat-Oman

Categories of passengers allowed to Travel

- Omani Nationals
- Non-Omani Citizen with valid residency permits.

Conditions / Requirement for passengers to Oman

1. Non-Omani citizens travelling to Oman are required to be in possession of valid International health insurance covering the cost of Covid-19 treatment for a period of at least one month.
 2. Passengers will have to download and complete registration on Tarassud+ app before arrival in Oman.
 3. Passengers travelling to Oman for a period of 1 to 7 days shall undergo Covid-19 PCR test upon arrival and are required to pay the cost of services of OMR 25 through Tarassud+ App.
 4. Passengers travelling to Oman for a period of more than 7 days shall undergo Covid-19 PCR test upon arrival along with 14 days home quarantine and are required to pay the cost of services of OMR 25 through Tarassud+ App. Customers will also be provided with a bracelet to be worn for a period of 14 days.
 5. Passengers who have exceeded their stay for more than 180 days in India should hold Form 1A and NOC from Oman sponsor.
 6. Children aged 15 years and less shall be exempted from Covid-19 PCR test upon arrival.
 7. As per guidelines issued by the immigration authorities of Oman, with immediate effect, passengers holding any category of newly issued visa will not be allowed to enter until further notice. Only existing residence / employment visa holders and those who have renewed their existing visas will be accepted on flights to Muscat.
