

INDIA to GERMANY

Conditions / Requirement

1)Entry of Citizens : Yes

2)**Compulsory Home Quarantine 14 days**

3)All non essential entry into Germany is prohibited for holders of Schengen - Visa and of Visas of Category D (long term)

Following are permitted and are exempt from entry restriction:

3) Holders of Residence permits (Aufenthaltserlaubnis) and Permanent residence permits (Niederlassungserlaubnis)

4) Holders of Family Reunion Visas (Category D)

Holders of Long term (Category D) visas for employment in Health and Health research sectors, for care of elderly as well as specialists and highly qualified workers whose employment is economically necessary and whose work cannot be postponed or carried out abroad

5) Long term (Category D) visas for study purposes as long as the studies cannot be carried out completely from abroad

6) Proof of Eligibility has to be presented at immigration point in Germany, e.g copy of marriage (registration) certificate as well as Passport and Residence Permit of spouse residing in Germany, confirmation issued by employer / university about mandatory physical presence in Germany

7)Transit is permitted to other EU countries where entry is allowed, and to onward travel to non-EU countries when Schengen transit visa waiver is applicable (e.g for holders of Green Cards of USA or Canada)
