

INDIA to UAE

Conditions / Requirement

1. UAE nationals and ICA approved UAE residents are permitted to travel
2. All passengers must have the Covid 19 DXB Smart App and Al-Hosn UAE installed in their mobile phones
3. All passengers travelling to Dubai must carry their Covid-19 negative report from the ICMR approved laboratory. Negative Covid-19 certificates will be valid only for 96 hrs from the time of the PCR test.
4. Children under the age of 12 years and/or those with moderate to severe disabilities are exempted from the PCR test.
5. Some passengers may have to undergo another PCR test on arriving at Dubai.
6. All passengers are required to fill in the Health Declaration Form, prior to their travel to Dubai. ([click here](#))
7. Submit Quarantine Undertaking form ([click here](#))
8. For the convenience of passengers SpiceJet will also provide a complimentary drop, by coaches, from Ras-al-Khaimah airport to the following locations in UAE upon arrival.
9. With immediate effect passengers travelling to Dubai on tourist / visit visa or planning to obtain "**Visa on Arrival**" are mandatorily required to be in possession of a valid return ticket. In the absence of having a valid return ticket, the passengers will be denied entry in Dubai and shall be deported at their own cost and expenses.

"Ok to Board" permission is NOT required for:

- Customers holding a valid Resident Permit or passport stamped with Resident Visa
- Customers eligible for "Visa on Arrival" irrespective of nationality
- Customers travelling with a print-out of Business and Tourist e-Visa

"Ok to Board" permission is required for:

- All customers holding ECR (Emigration Check Required) passport
- All customers travelling with a print-out of **Labour & Work e-Visa**.

Note : Passengers will be vetted by the airport staff at the Check-in counter. Those who are not able to furnish the aforementioned documents and app will be denied boarding.

Important Update for Passenger travelling to Dubai: (till 22nd October 2020)

Please note that as per Dubai Civil Authorities the RT-PCR Test done by the following laboratories shall not be accepted for passengers travelling to Dubai.

- Noble Diagnostic Centre, Delhi

Important Update for Passenger travelling to Dubai: (from 23rd October 2020)

This is to inform you that as per Dubai Civil Authorities, the RT-PCR Test done by the following laboratories shall not be accepted for passengers travelling to Dubai:

Important Update for Passenger travelling to Ras Al Khaimah: (from 2nd Feb 2021)

With immediate effect, ICA approval is not required before arriving in Ras Al Khaimah for passengers holding a residence visa issued from all Northern Emirates (Sharjah, Ajman, Fujairah, Ras Al Khaimah, Umm Al Quwain), Al Ain and Abu Dhabi.

Note: GDRFA approval is still required for all passengers holding a residence visa issued from Dubai.

Conditions / Requirement for travel effective 22nd April 2021

Kindly note, effective 22nd April 2021 all passengers travelling from any point in India to Dubai are requested to carry a Negative RT-PCR report with mandatory QR code which is linked to the original report.

Passengers will not be allowed to travel without QR code shown on the RT-PCR report.

(VALID Covid-19 Test certificate should indicate NEGATIVE that is issued within the valid time frame, namely, 48 hours from the time of collecting the sample and also ensure that the time of sample collection - "Date & Time" and time of reporting "Result date and Result time" are accurate.)

UAE to INDIA

Conditions / Requirement

1. Only Indian nationals stranded in UAE, and UAE national eligible to enter India as per the Ministry of Home Affairs' guidelines are permitted to travel to India. Please check the MHA guidelines.
2. All passengers must have the Aarogya Setu App installed on their mobile phones.
3. All passengers arriving from Dubai into India must submit a self-declaration form on the online portal www.newdelhiairport.in , prior to their travel.

4. An undertaking must also be submitted for accepting that they would undergo mandatory paid institutional quarantine for 7 days followed by home quarantine for 7 days.
 5. Passengers without symptoms arriving from international flights are exempted from institutional quarantine if they are travelling under exceptional and compelling circumstances, such as pregnancy, death in family, serious illness, and parent(s) accompanied by children of the age of 10 years or below, or those who are travelling due to personal distress. However, these passengers will have to undergo mandatory 14 days of home quarantine.
 6. Exemption from institutional quarantine can be sought if they have applied for it online on www.newdelhairport.in, at least 72 hrs prior to their flight. Alternatively, such passengers can also submit a negative Covid-19 RT-PCR test report on arrival. This test should have been conducted within 96 hrs prior to their flight. The test report should also be uploaded on the portal for consideration.
 7. Please check more detailed guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
 8. All passengers must fill the online health declaration form under COVID updates (Air Suvidha) on the link <https://www.newdelhairport.in/airsuvidha/apho-registration> at least 72 hours before the scheduled arrival in India. Passengers will receive an approval code that must be presented at the Arrival Health Counter.

 - a. Note: Applications are being accepted on behalf of the State Government and the Form needs to be applied at least 72 hours prior to flying.
 10. All passengers are requested to check the Country/State website before travel.
