

INDIA to BANGLADESH

Conditions / Requirement

- All customers arriving in Bangladesh are required to fill a self-health declaration form and submit the same to the health authorities upon arrival
- Bangladeshi nationals or Bangladeshi origin foreign passport holders with a 'No visa required for Bangladesh' stamp or sticker in their passport are required to have a negative AT PCA certificate issued within 72 hours of their travel
- The certificate must be available in printed form to submit to health authorities upon arrival and shall be in English only: handwritten certificates are not permitted.
- Bangladeshi nationals or Bangladeshi origin foreign passport holders with a 'No visa required for Bangladesh' stamp or sticker in their passport who do not have a negative AT PCA certificate shall be required to undergo a mandatory 14-day quarantine in a government-approved quarantine centre.

Note: Children under 10 years are exempted from Pre-COVID test and 14-day quarantine in a government-approved quarantine centre

- Foreign nationals with a valid visa for Bangladesh are allowed to travel to Bangladesh and shall mandatorily have a negative RT PCR certificate issued within 72 hours of their travel. Customers not in possession of a valid negative RT PCR certificate shall not be allowed to board the flight.

Note: Children under 10 years are exempted from Pre-COVID test

- The certificate must be available in printed form to submit to health authorities upon arrival and shall be English only: handwritten certificates are not permitted.

Eligibility of passengers travelling to Bangladesh from India as on 29th October 2020:

1. Nationals/residents of Bangladesh and foreign nationals holding a valid visa from Bangladesh
2. Any Indian national holding any type of valid visa from Bangladesh

Apart from meeting the eligibility criteria to travel, carrying a COVID-19 Negative Certificate after duly completing PCR test within 72 hours of journey is mandatory for passengers from both the countries. Passengers must adhere to the SOP issued by the Ministry of Civil Aviation and other COVID-19 related guidelines issued by MHA and MoH&FW.

BANGLADESH to INDIA

Conditions / Requirement

- Eligibility to travel to India Indian nationals: All Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) cardholders holding passports issued by Bangladesh, and Bangladeshi nationals/residents (including diplomats) and foreigners (including diplomats) holding valid visa issued by an Indian Mission in any category covered under Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) guidelines dated 30.06.2020

ELIGIBILITY FOR PASSENGERS TRAVELING FROM BANGLADESH TO INDIA as on 29th October 2020

1. Indian nationals
2. Il Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholders holding passports issued by Bangladesh
3. Bangladeshi nationals/residents (including diplomats) and foreigners (including diplomats) holding a valid visa issued by an Indian Mission in any category covered under the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) guidelines dated 30.6.2020 as amended from time to time.
